Formatting Dates and Decimal numbers

When a number or date is pasted, if Spider is not able to automatically determine the source format (e.g. if you copied from a text file or an Excel worksheet with wrong format) a pop-up will appear asking for the decimal separator, thousand separator and date format to use in order to interpret copy-paste input. Note that, once inserted, this setting will be retained throughout the current Spider session.

However, it is possible to modify it using the command in menu Edit → Number and date format.

Item Delete notification

At saving time, a notification will be sent to all users who have READ or READ / WRITE permissions on any datasheet that import item(s) removed/recovered. The new email variable that contains the concerned documents is `AFFECTED_DOCS`.

Item Composition

Now you can specify that a single Item Composition rule will be checked when a document is loaded, selecting the option "Check on opening doc" in the "Item Composition" form of Spider.

When a coding document is opened, if it contains items that violate this rule, a warning message will be shown to the user who may decide to continue without performing an action or to review the items with wrong tags (this choice corresponds to manually run "Check Item Composition" functionality).

Text cells with suggestion list

When you are on a text cell with a suggestion list, the cell tooltip highlight this, showing the list name.

It is possible to right-click and select "Suggestion list..." (or use the shortcut Alt + Down Arrow) to show a selection form similar to the one of Global list cells.

It is possible to set a suggestion list for a particular cell in SpiderConfigurator.

Document Split

In the Spider context menu for GRID documents, in the "Grid Tools" sub-menu, it was introduced a new feature to split the document into 4 panels similar to the Excel function "Split".

Formula values in the database

The formula results in the Excel spreadsheet can be saved in the database. The values, which were previously only shown in the video, can then be published in the documents designated in the workflow. Data will be also available, for the various calculations, in plug-ins and reports.

To ensure that the formula results will be stored in the database you must, in the Spider Configurator:

- Configure the cell not using the type "Formula" but with the designated type to contain the value (for example, Date, Text or Int)
- Enter the formula in the designated cell.

Revisions approval workflow

Added a feature that allows to issue the revision of one or more types of datasheets, following a structured flow defined by the system administrator. The approval workflow requires that you define some "states" (e.g.: Prepared, Checked, Approved, etc.), their sequence order, and the users (through roles) that can make the revision approval continue, or block the revision.

The datasheet will be treated and marked as reviewed only after the proper approval sequence.

Excel Filters

You can now have the Excel style filters in GRID-type documents. if the Spider template has configured the excel filters, the old Spider filters are disabled. You can also show or hide the Excel style filters directly in Spider application.

Permissions on custom commands

It is now possible to assign permissions to custom commands as any other Spider entry points. You can assign permissions to a role by using the appropriate form in the Database Manager application.

NOTE FOR DEVELOPERS: if, in your plugin, you have one or more custom commands you must add this source code to your custom command class and recompile the container assemblies:

Get All from plugins

The Spider document tree now shows a full or empty folder, depending on whether there are some documents or not in that folder.

Spider Plugins

In this release, the following features have been added regarding the plugins:

- ISpiderSheet.IsHidden: used to determine if the section (sheet) is hidden or showed
- ISpiderDocument.IsProjectSetup: used to determine if the current document is the Project Setup document
- ISpiderDocument.TemplateCode: Returns the template code of the current document
- ISpiderProvider.SpiderInstallationFolder: returns the folder containing the application files
- ISpiderProvider.SpiderPluginsFolder: returns the plugin folder
- Added some SpiderProvider methods to insert images within the current document
- Added some methods to filter the global / project list values within a single cell
- Added two new events DocumentPublishing and DocumentPublished to control the data pre- or post-publication
